

Summary of Business conducted at the A.G.M. held at the Crown Inn on Tuesday 26th October 2021 starting at 8.00 pm

Fifteen members were present. There was one apology for absence.

A Minute's Silence was observed in memory of deceased Members.

The Minutes of A.G.M. 2019 were read and approved as a true record.

The Treasurer's Report was discussed and accepted unanimously.

Proposals Discussed and Accepted as Rules/Standing Orders.

- Pegs/platforms must not be modified without Committee approval.
- 25% per Working Party discount, up to 75% maximum, when renewing Membership the following year.
- OAP Membership starts in the year following the 65th birthday year.
- Proposals for new Rules/Standing Orders etc. must show the printed names and signatures of Proposers and Seconders.
- No hook larger than size 10 to be used on any G.A.A.S. Water.
- No braid to be used as a hooklength on any G.A.A.S. Water.
- Night fishing is now permitted on the Padfield Water.
- No leger/feeder fishing on Top and Bottom Lodges, North Road.
- Keepnet use is **not permitted** on any G.A.A.S. Water except in a Match with prior Committee approval.
- When/if used, keepnets, landing nets, unhooking mats, weighing slings etc. must be clean and dry as per E.A. recommendations.

Election of Officers

Mr. C. Brooks (Chairman) resigned. A big "Thank You" for his many years of Service.

Mr. F. Matthews was elected as our new Chairman.

All other Officers and Committee Members were re-elected.

Mr. Derek Orr, who served as a Committee Member for many years died in July 2021. **R.I.P.**
