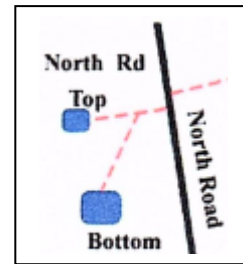


Directions:-

From A57 turn up Arundel street, go under railway bridge, turn left onto North road. Proceed up North road, through the cross roads until you reach a stretch with no buildings on left hand side, the stile for access to lodges is on left hand side. Go over stile and follow path straight across field to lodge. You will need the code to gate lock



Fish Stock:-

Carp, Chubb, Bream, Roach and perch

Baits, Tips and Tactics:-

If fishing for Roach, same tactics as top pond but, you will have to beef up your tackle to 5lb mainline and 4lb hook lengths as a minimum, because if you hit a Carp or Chubb, they will take you into the Lilly's and they will snap you off.

If after the Bream/ Carp then tradition methods work best. Cheese paste, Bread paste, Luncheon meat, Dead maggots, punched bread, floating bread, dog biscuits, Expanders and jellied expanders. They are not used to ground bait, but either liquidised bread or Hemp works wonders for attracting them to your swim. Lilly's are their home ground and fishing close to them will always get you a bite, but I would go up to 8lb mainline to stand a chance in the Lilly's. All the bigger fish are margin swimmers and just chucking a float 2ft from the bank has as good a chance of hooking into a bigger fish as anywhere else on the pond. Chubb tend to be in the deeper parts of the pond, which is the section to the trees as you first go onto the pond and towards the fish safe.
